







MONO COUNTY CASES BY REGION

Mono County and CA Case Summary By Area






Total Positive Cases for Mono County Residents (last 30 d...

BLUEPRINT FOR A SAFER ECONOMY – PURPLE TIER



- Mono County data* used to determine Tier Status:
 - 5.1 Case Rate/100,000
 - 2.6% Testing Positivity rate
- A county must have been in the current tier for a minimum of three weeks.
- A county must meet criteria for the next less restrictive tier for both measures for the prior two consecutive weeks in order to progress to the next tier.



MONO COUNTY COVID-19 VACCINE DASHBOARD



Mono County Public Health has received **10,528** doses of vaccine and issued:

- 4,695 first doses
- 3,993 second doses





COVID-19 VACCINATION PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY REQUIRED



- Vaccines are allocated by the state according to permanent resident population, so vaccination
 appointments are only for people who work or live in Mono County, regardless of immigration
 status.
- To ensure Mono County is administering vaccines according to <u>State guidelines</u>, proof of eligibility is now required at the vaccination clinic.
- Proof of Mono County residence or employment is required. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Driver's license/Real ID
 - U.S. Postal Service change of address
 - Employment paystub
 - Note from employer
 - Employee ID
 - Any document that verifies you as a Mono County, full-time resident (<u>second homeowners are</u> not eligible to receive the vaccine in Mono County)

Call (760) 924-1830 and follow the vaccination prompts for help completing the vaccine questionnaire or for vaccine questions. Be prepared to leave a short message with your name and phone number



Email COVID19help@mono.ca.gov for help completing the vaccine questionnaire or forvaccine questions.

The completion of they accine question raine does not utomatically register you for your accination. Once clinics are scheduled for your established criteria you will receive an invitation at the appointed time to register for your first and second vaccination. Clinics are by appointment ONLY.





Once direits are scheduled for each tier/phase, you will receive an invitation at the appointed time to register for your first and second vaccination. Please do not arrive at any clinic unless you have an appointment. On-site registration is not available at this time and slows down the vaccination process for others. Vaccination appointments are for people who work or five in Mono County, regardless of immigration status. Your ID or proof of local employment and/or full-time residence may be required at the vaccination dinic.





Arrive at your direct your appointed time. Wear a t-shirt under your layers. You will receive your vaccination card on-site. which you will need for your second vaccination.





Continue to keep wearing a mask, wash your hands, stay 6 Feet apart, and do not gather indoors with those outside of your immediate household unit until the vaccine has been widely distributed.



WHERE ARE WE NOW?



Mono County is now vaccinating residents aged 50 years and older, and residents aged 16 years and older with certain underlying medical conditions, including pregnant women of any age. These individuals are at increased risk for severe illness from the virus that causes COVID-19. Some of the higher risk underlying medical conditions include:

- Cancer
- Chronic kidney disease
- COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease)
- Down Syndrome
- Heart conditions, such as heart failure, coronary artery disease, or cardiomyopathies
- Immunocompromised state (weakened immune system) from solid organ transplant
- Obesity and severe obesity
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell disease
- Type 1 and 2 diabetes mellitus
- Asthma (moderate-to-severe)

- Cerebrovascular disease (history of stroke or TIA)
- Cystic fibrosis
- Hypertension or high blood pressure
- Immunocompromised state (weakened immune system) from blood or bone marrow transplant, immune deficiencies, HIV, use of corticosteroids, or use of other immune weakening medicines
- Neurologic conditions, such as dementia
- Liver disease
- Pulmonary fibrosis (having damaged or scarred lung tissues)
- Thalassemia (a type of blood disorder)

- The California Department of Public Health is transitioning all California counties to the My Turn platform for COVID-19 vaccine registration.
- Mono County will begin piloting the My Turn platform later this month.
- Currently pre-registered individuals will be transferred over by Mono County Public Health.

COVID-19 vaccination: Find out if it's your turn

Everyone in California will have an opportunity to get vaccinated against COVID-19 at no cost. But our vaccination supply is limited right now. So we're starting with the groups who are at highest risk, like people with a high chance of exposure and people 65 and older.


Are you eligible?

Find out if it's your turn by answering a few questions. It only takes a few minutes. If you're eligible and vaccine appointments are available through My Turn, you can schedule one. If it's not your turn yet or appointments are not available, you can register to be notified when you're eligible or when appointments open up.
