









TOTAL POSITIVE CASES (PCR CONF): 2963 POSITIVITY RATE: 8.2% CASE RATE/100,000: 3.1

#### **OMICRON BA.2**

- The Omicron variant spreads more easily than the original <u>SARS-CoV-2</u> strain of the virus that causes COVID-19, and previous variants, including Delta.
- According to Danish scientists, the Omicron subvariant BA.2, is 1 ½ times more transmissible than the original Omicron strain.
- While there is currently no evidence that the BA.2 lineage is more severe than the BA.1 lineage, experts have warned that BA.2 could extend the current wave of COVID-19 infections in the U.S.
