

To the Mono County Board of Supervisors,

The June Lake Community Advisory Committee (CAC) has heard continuing dire concerns from the community regarding the lack of housing in the Eastern Sierra. In June Lake in particular there is a dearth of housing available particularly on the affordable end of the spectrum. There are now locals running afoul of regulations concerning RV use as housing.

In the recent past county staff had been working on ways that Recreational Vehicles and Tiny Homes could be used to alleviate some of the housing issues.

The CAC hereby asks the Board of Supervisors to instruct staff to prioritize RV use exploration, due to limited bandwidth as staff is thin currently. We request that Staff continue to work on the possible solutions and ways RVs could be used in a structured and limited fashion for housing in the Eastern Sierra. Having seen several make it through our recent record breaking winter in a 5<sup>th</sup> wheels and tiny homes there is clearly the ability to use these types of homes to live and enjoy life in the Eastern Sierra and June Lake in particular. With proper hookups and structured rules it seems, and perhaps a permitting process it seems RVs could be approved in a structured, methodical way.

Please instruct staff to continue their work on using RVs and Tiny Houses as a temporary solution to our long term problem of low housing.
