Changes under #7, bylaws from 2019 meeting.

A. County Counsel determination on LAFCO questions at May 15 meeting: Statement on quorum. Tie is denial. Ask County Counsel best way to eliminate confusion. No conflict with Tri-Valley Groundwater Management District's evening meeting.

Clarify budget: Sometimes % of fee to run LAFCO. Town 1/3, Mono 1/3, two largest districts 1/3.

Brown: Few years ago, properties in Bridgeport annexed into Bridgeport PUD MCWD. This was a correction to PUD boundaries as the District was providing services for many years to various parcels Short-sighted on development, LAFCO, Mono, Town?

Le Francois: The MCWD annexation missed negotiation on property taxes. Allows master agreement. Better to negotiate before annexation. Not within district boundaries should have been caught by Mono in earlier stages. Bridgeport PUD: Tax collector noted discrepancy, a cleanup item.

Stump: Its own facility was outside boundary.

Cage: Clean up tax issue on annexed parcels? Le Francois: Ask County Counsel, auditor.

Cage: Consistency good. Mosquito Abatement sharing facility with SAR (Search & Rescue).

Request from Commission Cage and Woodworth when we have a large gap in scheduled meetings, staff should send the minutes out for Commissioner review, so changes can be made while still relevant.

MOTION: Amend minutes from June 26, 2019. Vote- (6) Ayes (0) Noes.

5. REVIEW and consider Preliminary Budget 2020-21 and provide any desired direction to staff.

Cage: Requesting actuals from last year budget as part of budget adoption process and prior years if available.

LeFrancois: Under Budget, discussed staffing changes and expenses related to the Wheeler Crest CSD Annexation. At the time, Haber properties did appear outside of district boundaries, staff processed, Commission approved the annexation last year. Board of Equalization would not accept tract map descriptions as written in order to file this boundary change with BOE. This was processed at no charge to the Wheeler Crest CSD as a cleanup item.

Brown: Can applicant be billed?

LeFrancois: Nothing would compel the developer to pay after the fact.

Stump: Requesting staff to inform the CSD Board about this issue and provide updates, as necessary.

LeFrancois: Commission staff found the 1994 Annexation into the Wheeler Crest CSD as part of the Rim Rock Ranch Specific Plan and various tract maps. Staff is working with Public Works to see if legal descriptions do indeed include the Haber parcels.

Kalish (Alternate Public Member): Attendance should not be an issue going forward. Gave the example of the Public Utilities Commission allowing for remote meeting locations and participation since most of the meetings are in San Francisco.

LeFrancois: Current Executive Orders for Governor Newsom allow for a bit more flexibility under the Brown Act for remote meeting due to Covid-19.

RECOMMENDATION

After the close of the Public Hearing, consider, and adopt the 2020-21 LAFCO Budget.

BACKGROUND

The Budget for fiscal year 2020-21 must be at least equal to the budget adopted for the previous fiscal year unless the Commission finds that reducing staffing or program costs will still allow the LAFCO to fulfill the purposes and requirements of the Act. The preliminary budget of \$11,019 was considered by your Commission on May 28th.

The current fiscal year 2019-20 budget is \$11,114. As of June 16, expenses / revenues are approximately \$9,395. Once all current fiscal year expenses are accounted for, any remaining funds will be rolled over to the 2020-21 budget.

Attached is the proposed 2020-21 budget of \$11,019, a summary of the actual budget for the current fiscal year 2019-20, and the general ledger from the current fiscal year.

ALTERNATIVE APPORTIONMENT

The CKH Act establishes methods for apportioning LAFCO staffing and program costs among the County, Town and special districts. The law allows alternative apportionment methods, which Mono LAFCO has used in the past to avoid impacting financially constrained special districts. Prior to using an alternative apportionment method, LAFCO costs were fully borne by the Town of Mammoth Lakes and Mono County. In recent years, the Commission applied an alternative apportionment method consisting of a third from Mono County; a third from the Town of Mammoth Lakes; and a third from special districts, with the special district share provided exclusively from the Southern Mono Healthcare District and the Mammoth Community Water District, rather than from all independent special districts.

The proposed preliminary budget reflects this same alternative budget apportionment method, which consists of a third (\$3,673) from Mono County; a third (\$3,673) from the Town of Mammoth Lakes; and a third (\$3,673) from the special districts. Instead of all independent special districts in Mono County contributing, this alternative apportionment consists of \$1,836.50 from Southern Mono Hospital District and \$1,836.50 from the Mammoth Community Water District.

FY 2020-21 BUDGET

The attached Preliminary Budget for fiscal year 2020-21 maintains a status-quo funding level. This level of funding has been sufficient for LAFCO activity this past year. The main staff activity included:

- Review of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Act;
- Reviewing current Sphere of Influence and Municipal Service Review of all special districts.
- Provided comments to CD4 project revised mitigation measures on LAFCO procedures.

Anticipated work tasks for 2020-21 include:

- Consider LAFCO policies in updating housing policies and mitigation requirements;
- Attend staff training;
- Review LAFCO agriculture preservation policies as a part of a Sustainable Agriculture grant;
- Assess water service providers, including irrigation services, as a part of the Walker River Water Transfer Study and EIR;
- Respond to future application activity, and special district inquiries;
- Update municipal service reviews of fire districts (Planning Division has applied for a grant to fund this) and
- Review plans, projects, and environmental documents for LAFCO concerns.

This expected level of activity, which is similar to last year, is reflected in the attached recommended FY 2020-21 Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Receive verbal update on Special District Alternate Member nominations and Public Member Alternate process

BACKGROUND

Special District Alternate Member

The nominations and election process for the Alternate Special District Member will be conducted by electronic mail per Govt. Code Section 56332 (f) (3) (4). Each Special District may submit nominations in writing (see attached nomination form). Candidates for this position must be elected or appointed by their own Special District officers residing within the county. Notices were sent via electronic mail on June 8 and nominations must be received at the LAFCO offices by **July 17, 2020**. Nominations received after that date will not be considered. If only one candidate is nominated for a vacant seat, that candidate shall be deemed appointed and the meeting may be cancelled as permitted by Govt. Code Section 56332 (c) (1) (2).

If more than one Alternate Special District Member has been nominated, the Executive Officer will prepare a ballot and send one copy to each Special District via electronic mail (per Govt. Code Section 56332 (f) (3) (4)), along with voting instructions. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be appointed as the Alternate Special District member.

Public Member Alternate

Notice of a Public Member Alternate will be published next week. Govt Code Section 56325 (d) allows for one member representing the general public appointed by the other members of the commission. The other members of the commission may also appoint one alternate member who shall serve pursuant to Govt Code Section 56331. Appointment of the public member and alternate public member shall be subject to the affirmative vote of at least one of the members appointed by each of the other appointing authorities. Whenever a vacancy occurs in the public member or alternate public member position, the commission shall cause a notice of vacancy to be posted as provided in Section 56158. A copy of this notice shall be sent to the clerk or secretary of the legislative body of each local agency within the county. Final appointment to fill the vacancy may not be made for at least 21 days after the posting of the notice.
