## MONO COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH LAUNCHES COVID-19 TEST-TO-TREAT PROGRAM

**September 26, 2022** – Effective October 2022, Mono County Public Health (Public Health) will be taking over all COVID-19 (Coronavirus) testing in Mono County, and launching a COVID-19 Test-to-Treat program. At COVID-19 Test-to-Treat clinics, individuals can get tested, be seen by a health care provider, and receive a prescription for medication – all in one location.

*“There has been a steady decline in COVID-19 transmission in our community, and moving to a Test-to-Treat program will help to identify infection early, and provide individuals with the care they need quickly,”* said Dr. Caryn Slack, MD, MPH, Mono County Health Officer. *“We are proud to be able to provide this service to our community.”*

The Public Health Test-to-Treat clinics will replace the OptumServe clinics. The October 2022 COVID-19 Test-to-Treat schedule is as follows:
