

FAVORITE LOCAL TRAILS AROUND POORE LAKE

Located about 6 miles off Sonora Junction, Poore Lake is situated in breathe-taking alpine meadows. Highlighted by the meandering West Walker River and snow capped peaks, this place is truly rugged and scenic! Passing Poore Lake and continuing on to Sonora Pass, visitors can even access a segment of the Pacific Crest Trail.



Trail Name: Leavitt Meadow/Poore Lake Trail

Trail Type: Hiking, Equestrian
Length: 9.3 mi

Description:

From Bridgeport, take US 395 north to Highway 108. Take highway 108 west for 7 miles to Leavitt Meadow Campground. Park at the campground and take the Leavitt Meadow Trailhead, following it through the stunning alpine meadow as it parallels the West Walker River. After 2.5 miles take a left towards the beautiful Secret and Poore lakes. Enjoy the scenery as the trail winds around the south shore of Poore Lake, eventually wrapping around and looping back to Sonora Pass. This loop can easily be broken into

Trail Name: Silver Creek Road

Trail Type: Off-Highway Vehicles
Length: 10.5 mi

Description:

Silver Creek Road offers visitor a nice off-road experience with amazing vistas of the Sierra crest and Silver Creek. From Bridgeport, take US 395 north to Highway 108. Stay on Highway 108 for 3.9 miles and make a right into the Mountain Warfare Training Center. Proceed to the gate and explain that you are accessing Silver Creek Road. The Marines at the gate can provide directions to the trailhead. Most of Silver Creek Road is passable in 2-wheel drive, but be warned that weather can quickly alter road conditions.
