### Mexican Mobile Consulate Assists 297 Families in Mono County

In response to severe winter storms, and the subsequent difficulty in travel, the Department of Social Services requested that the Mexican Consulate come to Mono County on May 6th and provide services such as passports, visas, certifications, civil registry acts, issuance of notarial powers, military services, and credentials to vote abroad.

The need was considerable that all appointments were booked within the first two hours of advertising the event.

**The Mexican Consulate assisted 250 individuals in obtaining a valid form of ID and accommodated another 33 individuals, which had not been able to register for an appointment. Overall, the Mexican Consulate from Sacramento assisted 297 families.**

The event took place at the Mono County Civic Center, which served as a launching pad to promote, other services such as CalFresh, Medi-Cal and CalWorks among other programs. In addition, Covid-19 tests were provided for our residents.

The Department of Social Services would like to thank the Mexican Consulate and the Consulado Movil for providing these services to our families.

We would also like to thank Old New York Deli, Giovanni's Restaurant, John's Pizza, Juniper Springs and Mono County Social Services for their generous donations. It takes a community to bring events such as these to Mono County to serve our families.

## Consulado Móvil de México Asiste a 297 Familias en Condado de Mono

En respuesta a las severas tormentas invernales y la subsiguiente dificultad para viajar, el Departamento de Servicios Sociales solicitó que el Consulado de México viniera al condado de Mono el 6 de mayo y brindara servicios como pasaportes, visas, certificaciones, actas de registro civil, emisión de poderes notariales, servicios militares, y credenciales para votar en el extranjero.

La necesidad era inmensa que todas las citas se agotaron dentro de las primeras dos horas de anunciar el evento.

**El Consulado de México ayudó a 250 personas en tramitar varios documentos y aparte atendió a otras 33 personas que no habían podido agendar cita. En total, el Consulado de México de Sacramento atendió a 297 familias.**

El evento se llevó a cabo en el Centro Cívico del Condado de Mono, que sirvió como plataforma de lanzamiento para promover otros servicios como CalFresh, Medi-Cal y CalWorks, entre otros programas. Además, se proporcionaron pruebas de Covid-19.

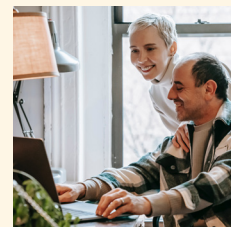

### BABIES

Your child's first dental visit should take place after their first tooth appears, but no later than their first birthday. Baby teeth are critical to your child's health and development. They help him or her chew, speak and smile.

### KIDS

Children start to lose their baby teeth as early as five years old. This is when their permanent teeth begin to grow in. Ask the dentist for molar sealants to help protect your child's molars from cavities.

### TEENS

Eating sugary foods and drinks, as teens often do, puts them at a higher risk for gum disease and tooth decay. Teenagers who continue to get regular check-ups ensure good oral health well into adulthood.

### PREGNANCY

Good oral health care helps prevent problems during pregnancy. As a Medi-Cal member, you are covered during pregnancy and 12 months after the birth of your baby.

### ADULTS

As you age, taking care of your health becomes more important. Regular dental visits keep your gums and teeth strong, and help with your overall health.

### SENIORS

Older adults are prone to gum disease and other oral health problems. You can lower your risk by brushing twice a day, flossing every day, and seeing your dentist regularly.

### BEBÉS

La primera visita dental de su hijo debe realizarse después de la aparición del primer diente, pero no después de su primer cumpleaños. Los dientes de leche son fundamentales para la salud y el desarrollo de su hijo. Le ayudan a masticar, hablar y sonreír.

### NIÑOS

Los niños comienzan a perder sus dientes de leche a partir de los cinco años de edad. Es entonces cuando comienzan a salirle los dientes permanentes. Pídale al dentista selladores de muelas para ayudar a prevenir caries en las muelas de su hijo.

### ADOLESCENTES

Consumir alimentos y bebidas azucaradas, como a menudo hacen los adolescentes, los pone frente a un mayor riesgo de desarrollar enfermedad de las encías y caries dentales. Los adolescentes que continúan realizándose controles regulares se aseguran una buena salud bucal hasta la edad adulta.

### EMBARAZO

El buen cuidado de la salud bucal ayuda a prevenir problemas durante el embarazo. Como miembro de Medi-Cal, los servicios dentales están cubiertos durante el embarazo y 12 meses después del nacimiento de su bebé.

### ADULTOS

A medida que envejece, cuidar su salud se vuelve más importante. Las visitas regulares al dentista mantienen sus encías y dientes fuertes y ayudan con su salud en general.

### PERSONAS MAYORES

Los adultos mayores son propensos a la enfermedad de las encías y otros problemas de salud bucal. Puede reducir su riesgo cepillándose los dientes dos veces al día, usando hilo dental todos los días y visitando a su dentista con regularidad.

The federally funded **Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)** offers up to \$30 a month off High-Speed Home Internet for qualifying households. Now everyone can get online at the same time for less. Those with Lifeline mobile benefits can also get ACP.

- 1 Check if You Qualify for the Affordable Connectivity Program**  
See if your household fits into any eligible categories.
- 2 Apply for the Affordable Connectivity Program**

- 3 Find a Broadband Provider Near You**  
Use the search tool [internetforallnow.org/acplans](https://internetforallnow.org/acplans) to find a company that offers ACP discounts. Prices for Internet service varies from \$10-\$30 a month which means after the discount is applied, Home Internet may be free.

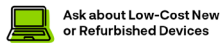


**To Be Eligible**

someone in your household must be enrolled in at least ONE (1) of the following:

- Lifeline
- Free or Reduced School Lunch Program, CEP Schools
- CalFresh or SNAP
- Medi-Cal or Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Pell Grant
- WIC (Women, Infants & Children)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Or has a Household Income of \$55,500 or less for a family of 4
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit

*Note:* The Internet Service Provider cannot require a waiting period or charge market rate before applying the ACP discount.

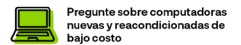

Are you an employer looking for help? The specific technical skills you need may be hard to find. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) On-the-Job Training Program helps you train the right workers to meet your requirements.

The WIOA wage reimbursement is 90% for employers that have 50 or less employees. Employers that have over 50 employees can receive a wage reimbursement of 50%.
