The Integrated Case Worker series differs from the Eligibility Specialist series in that the Integrated Case Worker provides both determination of eligibility for public assistance and basic employability services.

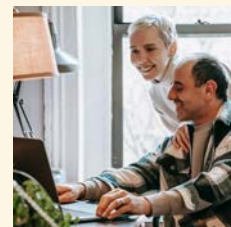

P-EBT 4.0 Is Coming to Eligible Families!

More breakfasts. More lunches. P-EBT 4.0 provides **more** food support to eligible families that have been impacted by COVID-19.

Más desayunos. Más almuerzos. La tarjeta P-EBT 4.0 brinda **más** apoyo alimentario a las familias elegibles afectadas por el COVID-19.

Here's What You Need to Know:

These benefits:

- Do NOT affect immigration, do not make you a public charge, and do not impact other benefits.
- Do NOT count as income and won't affect your taxes.
- Do NOT require an application. Families with eligible children will automatically get benefits.
- DO expire, so make sure you use them at least once every year.

Who Gets a P-EBT 4.0 Card:

Young children are eligible if they:

- were under age 6 as of August 1, 2022.
- AND were part of a household getting CalFresh Food benefits from August 2022-May 2023.

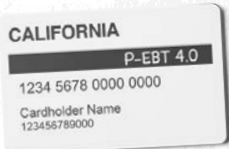
School-aged children are eligible if, during the 2022-2023 school year, they:

- were eligible for free or reduced-price meals;
- AND were enrolled in a school participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP)/ School Breakfast Program (SBP) or a Provision school;
- AND did not attend school in person or had five or more excused absences in any month due to COVID-19 (this includes students enrolled in virtual learning);
- were enrolled in a virtual school or homeschool. They may be eligible if they exited an in-person school after January 2020, and they must have been in Independent Study for the 2021-22 AND 2022-23 school years. These children can apply for P-EBT 4.0 benefits by visiting GetPEBT.org. Applications can be submitted between July 21, 2023 and August 15, 2023.
- can get Summer P-EBT benefits if they're eligible for free or reduced meals and attended National School Lunch Program (NSLP)/School Breakfast Program (SBP) or a Provision school as of May 2023.

How to Use Your Card:

When your P-EBT 4.0 card arrives in the mail, you will need to create a PIN (instructions will be sent with the card). Then use your card just like a debit card at the same places that take CalFresh Food benefits:

1. Pay by selecting "EBT" at checkout.
2. Swipe the card.
3. Enter the private PIN.



Use the QR code to learn what foods are covered.



Esto es lo que necesitas saber:

Estos beneficios:

- NO afectan tu estado migratorio, no te convierten en una carga pública y no afectarán tus otros beneficios.
- NO cuentan como ingreso y no afectarán tus impuestos.
- NO requieren una aplicación. Las familias con niños elegibles obtendrán beneficios automáticamente.
- Y si expiran, así que asegúrate de usarlos al menos una vez al año.

¿Quiénes recibirán una tarjeta de P-EBT 4.0?

Los niños pequeños pueden calificar si cumplen con estos dos requisitos:

- Tuvieron menos de 6 años en agosto 1, 2022;
- Y recibieron beneficios de comida de CalFresh al menos una vez entre agosto de 2022 y mayo de 2023.

Los niños en edad escolar pueden calificar si es que durante el año escolar del 2022-2023:

- Ellos fueron elegibles para recibir comidas gratuitas o a precio reducido;
- Y si es que estuvieron inscritos en una escuela que participa en el Programa Nacional de Almuerzo Escolar (NSLP, por sus siglas en inglés), en el Programa de Desayuno Escolar (SBP, por sus siglas en inglés) o en una escuela de Provisión;
- Y si es que no asistieron a la escuela en persona o tuvieron 5 o más ausencias justificadas en cualquiera de los meses debido al COVID-19 (esto incluye a estudiantes que se inscribieron en aprendizaje virtual)
- Estaban inscritos en una escuela virtual o recibían educación en el hogar
- O si salieron de una escuela en persona después de enero de 2020 y estaban en Estudios Independientes durante los años escolares 2021-2022 y 2022-2023.

Además, pueden obtener beneficios P-EBT de verano si son elegibles para recibir comidas gratis o a precio reducido y asistieron al Programa Nacional de Almuerzos Escolares (NSLP)/Programa de Desayunos Escolares (SBP) o a una escuela de Provisión a partir de mayo de 2023.

Estos niños pueden solicitar los beneficios P-EBT 4.0 visitando GetPEBT.org. Las solicitudes pueden entregarse del 21 de julio al 15 de agosto de 2023.

Cómo usar la tarjeta

Cuando tu tarjeta de P-EBT 4.0 llegue por correo, deberás crear un PIN (las instrucciones se enviarán con la tarjeta). Luego usa tu tarjeta como una tarjeta de débito en los mismos lugares que aceptan los beneficios de CalFresh Food:

1. Paga seleccionando "EBT" al finalizar la compra.
2. Desliza la tarjeta.
3. Introduce el PIN privado.

CalFresh, WIC and Medi-Cal Households Can Get Fast Home Internet for \$0 per month

The federally-funded Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) provides eligible households with a \$30 monthly discount on Home Internet plans. You can use the ACP discount with special low-cost internet plans that cost less than \$30 per month. That means your monthly Internet bill could be as low as \$0.

You are qualified!
If you or another household member receives CalFresh, WIC or Medi-Cal benefits, you automatically qualify for the ACP benefit.
